Dear teacher in charge of swimming

Sussex Schools Swimming is now accepting entries for the ESSA National Primary School Relay competition for 2015

This is a competition for a combined team from Year 5 and Year 6 pupils. I would like to offer your school the opportunity to compete in this years' competition for your school / club swimmers in your school. All events are 4 x 25m Freestyle and Medley Relays for both boys and girls. There are four sections depending on your year group size. If you have less than a combined total of 51 pupils in Yr 5 and Yr 6 then you can enter the small schools section. A new medium schools section has been introduced for schools with a combined total of less than 101 and more than 50 pupils in Yr 5 and 6. Small and medium school teams can be a combination of boys and girls. Otherwise you must enter the girls and boys separately. All sections have a 4 x 25m Free Relay and 4 x 25m Medley Relay. The competition regulations are available on the ESSA website (www.southeastschoolswimming.org.uk) .

The Sussex County Round is taking place on Wednesday 18th March 2015 at The Pavilions in the Park, Horsham with a 1.00pm warm up and 1.20pm start. The event should be over by 3.00pm.

If you wish to enter your school into this year's competition please fill out and return the entry form by Friday 6th March by email or post. Please find attached an entry form. There is a £10.00 Entry Fee per relay which includes both Freestyle and Medley. (**Payable to Sussex Schools Swimming Association**) which covers affiliation and administrative costs for the event.

All correspondence once entries are complete will be by email

The top two schools from the County round will qualify for the SE Regional Final (25th April at Spectrum Pool, Guildford) plus some fastest loser spots as well on time rankings from the SE. The top three schools in the SE Division will qualify for the National Finals being held in Sheffield in June.

Schools that are selected for the final will be notified as soon as possible after the Easter Holiday's and will be posted on the South East Schools web site, <http://www.southeastschoolswimming.org.uk> .
